

Minutes Of The Regular Meeting Of The Port Washington Garbage District  
Held On April 26, 2018

The meeting was called to order at 8:00am and began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Immediately after opening the meeting, the Commissioners entered into Public Forum. Steve Kaplan, resident and Safety Officer of Port Washington North, spoke. His concerns were over the changes to Yard Waste collection days. Some of his concerns were over how long a resident has to hold onto their yard waste before placing it curbside for pick-up, possible hazardous conditions created by the yard waste left curbside for multiple days and what that would do to each neighborhoods appearance. Commissioner Scaglione informed him of the different issues that brought about the change. Mr. Kaplan left the meeting after he was through speaking during the Public Forum with a final request that the Commissioners maintain a watchful eye on the change and how the residents are handling it. The Commissioners then continued on with the regularly scheduled meeting.

The minutes from the previous meeting held on April 12, 2018 were approved. Moved and seconded.

Attorney Stephen Ressa informed the Board that the RFP's for the District's Accountant were sent out and that the RFP's for the District's Independent Auditor were being completed for mailing.

The Commissioners discussed the upcoming Port Washington Garbage District Contract Bid Workshop to be held on May 8, 2018.

Phone calls and emails made to the District were discussed.

Various bills and invoices were reviewed and paid.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:45am. The next meeting of the Port Washington Garbage District will be held on Tuesday May 8, 2018 which will be a workshop for the District's Carting Contract Bid.
