

## **RESOLUTION**

**Adopted:** September 24, 2020

### **RESOLUTION REQUIRING THAT CANDIDATES FOR GARBAGE DISTRICT COMMISSION FILE THEIR NAMES WITH SECRETARY AND THAT NOMINATIONS BE SUBMITTED IN PETITION FORM**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Subdivision 20 of Section 215 of the Town Law the Board of Commissioners may provide by resolution that candidates for district offices shall file their names with the Secretary of the Board of Commissioners at least thirty (30) days prior to the date of the district elections and in addition, require that such nominations be submitted in petition form subscribed by twenty-five (25) registered voters of the district, and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners wishes to adopt a resolution as described in said Subdivision 20 of Section 215 of the Town Law requiring that candidates file their names with the Secretary of the Board of Commissioners and that nominations be in petition form;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that all candidates for district offices shall file their names with the Secretary of the Board of Commissioners at least thirty (30) days prior to the date of the district elections and all nominations shall be submitted in petition form subscribed by twenty-five (25) registered voters of the district.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Board of Garbage District Commissioners of the Port Washington Garbage District.
